From the Director's Chair

Welcome to the Greer Children's Theatre production of Disney's *Beauty and the Beast*. The ritual of the Legacy Robe takes place on the stage of every Broadway musical on opening night, before the audience is admitted. The tradition was started over 50 years ago by Bill Bradley, a chorus member in "Gentlemen Prefer Blondes." In a fun attempt to ease the jitters of a friend on the opening

night of "Call Me Madam," Bradley sent a dressing robe he received from another chorus member and claimed it was a legendary good luck charm worn by the beauties in the Ziegfeld Follies. Bradley also added a charm from his own successful show, a large rhinestone to represent the musical's hit song, "Diamonds Are a Girl's Best Friend." "Call Me Madam" garnered rave reviews. After including a rose from show star Ethel Merman's gown, Bradley's friend passed the robe to the next Broadway opening, "Guys and Dolls." The show was a hit. It was then passed from show to show in a haphazard way and was often presented to



a friend of the previous recipient, or awarded to a chorus member based on popularity. Through the years the passing of the Robe became a specific ceremony with official rules stating how it is presented, worn and paraded on stage. When a Robe is completely covered with artifacts, souvenirs and sketches, it is retired and a new one started. Three retired Robes are at the Lincoln Center Library of the Performing Arts; two are in the Smithsonian; and all others are with Actors' Equity.

The Greer Cultural Arts Council encourages you to recycle your playbill as you leave the auditorium. You can also save your playbills for autographs from the cast as you exit the show. Thank you for your cooperation.
